- Ability to read, write, follow written and verbal instructions, and document your progress.
- Ability to walk, bend, reach, squat, lift and carry up to 5 lbs., and push a cart up to 30 lbs.

- Attend an initial library orientation and a training specific to your duties.
- Receive on-going training and support as requested/needed.
- The size and number of shelves you'll adopt is flexible based on your preferred time commitment.
- No required end date stay as long as you like!
